

Journey in Ushant Island

DebConf 25 Day trip - Option D

Ushant (Eusa in Breton, Ouessant in French) is a French island located in the southwestern border of the English Channel. Being a vital point for maritime traffic to and from Northern Europe, Ushant is well known for its prominent lighthouses, especially the Créac'h lighthouse, the most powerful in Europe. Attendees may also come across local fauna, including (fenced) Ouessant sheep and goats.



For the day trip, a bus will **depart** from IMT Atlantique at **8:30** to the port of Le Conquet, where attendees will board a Penn ar Bed ferry to Ushant. The boat is scheduled to depart at 9:45, with an expected arrival on the island 1h20m later. Upon arrival, each attendee will be provided with a rented bicycle to explore the island.

Schedule

Time	
8:15	Meet at the venue (IMT Atlantique) for taking the bus
9:45	Boat departure from Le Conquet
-	Upon arrival to the island, the group picks up rented bikes next to the landing stage
17:45	Bike returns and group boards the boat
18:15	Boat departure from Ushant
19:45	Bus returns Le Conquet to the venue

- It is **required** to know how to **ride a bike**.
- This day trip requires a **STRICT SCHEDULE**, since the boat leaves on time, for both directions. The **orga team won't be responsible for transportation for people who miss any of the boats**.
